By registering, all participants give their consent that the media will be informed about the event. The information can also be published on the Internet, including the names, age classes and placements of participants. Photos and pictures relating to the event may also be published.

Tournament regulations

1. The U21 Tournament (*Nachwuchsturnier*) has been classified by tennis association TVN in the highest category (N1) and the Junior Tournament (*Jugendturnier*) as J2. Both will count towards German and individual association rankings.

2. All youth members of an association belonging to the German Tennis Federation (DTB) are entitled to play in the tournament. Priority will be given to players in the youth ranking lists of the DTB or the associations. An ID number is required for taking part in the tournament (exception: small court). These must be requested from the DTB in good time.

3. Priority will be given to applications from ranked players.

The tournament management reserves the right to change the tournament conditions and to refuse nominations without being required to state reasons.

4. The entry fee is to be transferred to the bank account specified above. Only participants who have paid the entry fee will be included in the draw. The entry fee cannot be refunded in the event that the tournament is cancelled owing to bad weather.

5. Players who do not turn up for one of their games after the draw in the tournament will be marked "n.a.". (Please note: As of the third "n.a.", they will be docked 150 points in the ladder ranking system each time. Even if a medical certificate is submitted, this will not affect the docking of points.)

6. The players are required to call the given telephone number at the specified times to find out the dates of their first match.

7. If required, qualifiers will be played one day before the official start of play. Players in the qualifiers will be informed about their match date.

8. The tournament will be played according to the rules of the ITF and the tournament regulations of the DTB/TVN.

9. The participants are required to register (or cancel their registration) with the tournament management in person.

10. The tournament balls will be Dunlop Fort Tournament (U10 – Dunlop Stage 1 green).

11. All matches will be the best of three sets, with a tiebreak played at 6-6.

12. The U10, U12, U14, U16 and U18 competitions include an additional knock-out competition for those who lost in the first round. To be included in this, the players in question must enter their names in the participant lists for this additional knock-out competition after their first-round match.

13. The winners and runners-up will receive cups and valuable non-cash prizes. In the case of the U21 competition, the distribution of prize money will be shown shortly afterwards online on www.duesseldorf-junior-open.de

U21 – Men: 1st place: €1,500 / 2nd place: €1,000 / 3rd–4th place: €600 / 5th–8th place: €200

U21 – Ladies: 1st place: €1,200 / 2nd place: €800 / 3rd–4th place: €500 / 5th–8th place: €125

The prize money based on 64 men and 32 women participants. In case of less participants the prize money will be reduced. The minimum of prize money (2000€ for each competition) for N1 category will be save. The participants are responsible for tax.

14. All participants must assume the function of umpire if required to do so.
